

# WILLMORE WILDERNESS GEAR LIST

You must pack all of your travel clothes in luggage that qualifies as a carry-on bag. You may also have a small personal bag like a school backpack for books, electronics, etc.

None of the BACKPACKING gear can be used for traveling. Your backpack will be 100% packed when it gets loaded on the plane. However, the clothes you will wear backpacking the first day should be packed with your travel clothes.

Remember that ounces add up to pounds. Always pick the lightest weight items that you have. Nylon or polyester weighs less and dries faster than cotton.

Zip Loc bags are great for organizing and packing all your gear. They are also an extra assurance that your stuff will stay dry. Gallon and quart size bags are available from the troop supply. 2 gallon bags are available from local stores and work well
